As we begin a new school year, it is an appropriate time to share our goals for your children. We wish to work with you as a team and to keep you informed of any changes, positive or otherwise, that may influence the behavior or character patterns of your child. Working as a team to help your child through various stages of early childhood, we can make a difference in promoting development. Children reach their full potential when we give them the opportunity to believe they are good, intelligent human beings who have many talents and abilities and deserve to be treated with respect and dignity. In our daily interactions we treat your children with affection, fairness, consistency, and friendship. We encourage responsibility, cooperation, good manners, honesty, and genuine achievement emotionally, socially, and academically. Children are the leaders of tomorrow, and have the ability to make the world a better place if we help them develop the skills to appreciate and respect themselves and others.

Goals

We are working on letter knowledge and phonics as well as math skills including place value and counting in Spanish, Japanese, Chinese, French, and English. Through activities with calendar, games and songs, the children learn the days of the week, months of the year, addition and subtraction.

Weekly themes include holidays, insects, seasons, planets, plants, dinosaurs, family, animals, volcanoes, the water cycle, fire safety, and historical figures.
